Drink riverside at a former Soviet hotel

Once a grey and block-like Soviet hotel, this riverside building has kept its communist-style exterior, which now serves as a retro facade for one of the coolest bars in town. While the rest of the building remains empty and abandoned, the ground floor is alive with locals. Forum Przestrzenie becomes a popular spot in the summer months, with hundreds of people spilling out onto the graveled front, pulling up deckchairs, crates, sun-loungers, and beanbags to lounge on and enjoy the view of the river. Take a refreshing pit-stop with a drink, stay a while longer, and sample some of the burgers, sandwiches, and pizzas. Or check out the nighttime scene for DJ sets and live music.
